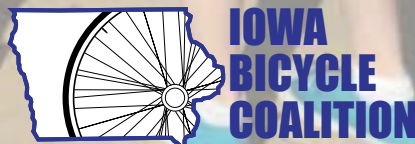


# Tips for Walking School Bus Drivers!



1. Student Safety is NUMBER ONE PRIORITY.
2. Be on time and stick to the published schedule.
3. Visually scan (left-right-left) at every intersection and driveway
4. Only enter the roadway if a 150 foot gap exists at unsignalized intersections.
5. Use a fresh phase at traffic lights with pedestrian signals to assure adequate time to cross.
6. Keep students together as a group.
7. Routes, procedures, and policies may be adjusted if the immediate safety of the students is at risk.
8. Other situations that could amend routes, procedures, and policies require approval of the walking school bus coordinator.
9. Students participating must be registered with the walking school bus program.
10. Adhere to the cancellation and severe weather policies.

# Tips for Walking School Bus Riders!



1. Be at your stop 5 minutes in advance.
2. Respect, listen, and follow the directions given by the drivers.
3. Walk between the drivers
4. Treat others the way you would like to be treated, by exercising good manners, caution, and consideration for others.
5. Respect private property and the environment.
6. Walk on the sidewalk or designated pathway.
7. Students must not have anything in their possession that may cause injury.
8. Students must follow pedestrian safety rules.
